

The Fulbright College Honors Studies Office is accepting applications for the Cambridge Study Abroad Program.

Each year the Fulbright College of Arts and Sciences Honors Studies Office selects two students for a year-long study in Cambridge, England. The Cambridge Program allows one position each at Corpus Christi College and Girton College and is reserved for Fulbright College of Arts and Sciences students who have a prestigious Fellowship (Sturgis, Bodenhamer, or Honors College Fellowship). This is a study abroad opportunity of the highest regard.

To apply, you must be rising junior (60 hours completed by end of the spring 2006 semester) or a rising fourth year senior with plans to graduate in five years.

The cost of attendance, as figured by the Study Abroad Office, is estimated at \$37,500.00.
